## Episode 025: Don't Kill the Messenger! (Exodus 4:21-26)

For one reason or another, Moses shirked one of his responsibilities as a father -- he failed to circumcise his son. Maybe his wife thought circumcision was a barbaric custom and he didn't want to offend her by insisting. Maybe he just didn't take God's commands all that seriously. Whatever the reason, his negligence almost cost him his life!
