## Episode 033: God's Tent ([Numbers 9:15-23](#))

In the years when Israel was in the wilderness with Moses, God's tent of meeting (along with the pillar of cloud by day and fire by night) was a visual reminder to His people that He was living among them and guiding them wherever they traveled.

- If you were an Israelite, traveling through the hostile wilderness to a land you will need to conquer, how would you find encouragement from seeing this tent of meeting going before you, along with the pillar of cloud?

In His incarnation, the Son of God became human and lived among us in the tent of His body. He traveled from place to place sharing the good news of God's Kingdom with His people. To all appearances, Jesus was an ordinary man—no different from the many Jews among whom He lived.

- Describe some of the ways God's people were able to clearly see that God was dwelling and moving among them in His Son Jesus?

Jesus still dwells with us today. In John 14:23 we read, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My Word, and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him." So you and I and all Christians are now the tents in which people can meet God.
