What Is Our Pastor's Job?

In Ephesians 4:11 Paul tells us God gave His church apostles, prophets, evangelists, shepherds and teachers (pastors)—and their job is to equip the saints for the work of ministry.

Submit to One Another

Paul's instructions were radical: husbands were to submit to their wives' needs, parents to their children, and masters to their slaves.

- What challenges and difficulties does a Christian husband face in our culture today?
- Describe what it looks like when parents truly submit to their children's needs?
- How can a boss or supervisor follow Paul's counsel to serve their employees?

Put on Your Armor

As we seek to submit ourselves to one another, Paul reminds us that we are engaging in a battle in the midst of an age-old war between good and evil: God and sin.

- Why is it significant that all but one piece of our armor is defensive?
- Looking at Jesus' temptation in the wilderness. How did He use the Word of God like a sword to attack Satan's lies?
- Why is learning the Scriptures so vital today?
